

Helpful Tips

1. **Double check that you have our correct address.** This is a rural location; some people have difficulty finding it. You may consider including a map in your invitations.
2. **East Canyon Resort, 8896 South Highway 65, Morgan, Utah 84050.**
3. **Condo check-in and check-out.** The condo check-in time is 4:00 PM and the check-out time is 10:00 AM. The bride is the only one allowed to check into the condos reserved for the wedding party unless prior arrangements have been made.
4. **Encourage your guests and officiate to arrive early.** Often weddings are delayed due to someone running late which can disrupt the scheduled events.
5. **Plan the transition from your ceremony to reception.** There tends to be a gap where guests do not know what to do. This is usually when the couple is taking wedding photos. Plan something for them to do, such as have a drink or enjoy some refreshments. Consider having the officiate give them verbal instructions of what is going to happen after the ceremony.
6. **Wait to set up the alcohol until after the bartender arrives.** No alcohol is allowed in public spaces until the bartender arrives. Alcohol set up usually takes longer than expected. Plan wisely to prevent your guests from waiting.
7. **All food must arrive ready to be served.** If you need space to prepare food for your guests, consider using your condo. If more space is required, renting the Event Center, which has a complete kitchen, would be a great option.
8. **Plan for someone to clear empty plates from the tables.** Clearing used plates and cups as the evening progresses will improve the visual aesthetic of the reception and will be appreciated by your guests.
9. **Consider the cleanup.** The wedding party is responsible for picking up anything thrown on the ground or in the air as well as the decorations. Although cleanup is faster than set up, make specific assignments for clean up to ensure a fast and easy tear down.
10. **Visual aesthetics.** A lot of effort goes into making sure everything looks perfect for your special day. Take the time to hide cardboard boxes, coolers, and unused supplies. If you are unsure where to store these items check with Special Events. Also consider using décor that is heavy or weighted down. The resort is situated in a canyon that frequently experiences a bit of wind.
